NY Waterway, which is run by Port Imperial Ferry Company and BillyBey Ferry Company, is the largest privately-owned ferry operator in the country, transporting nearly 35,000 riders daily across New York harbor and the East River. Founded by Arthur Imperatore Sr in 1986, NY Waterway's fleet of 33 ferries makes 8 million passenger trips per year and services 21 routes between New Jersey and Manhattan; between Brooklyn, Queens and Manhattan; between Rockland and Westchester counties; and between Orange and Dutchess counties.

NY Waterway ferries:

- provide comfortable seating in climate-controlled cabins
- offer exhilarating trips and the breath-taking views of Manhattan's East and West Side and the Brooklyn skyline
- each carry the same load of passengers as eight commuter buses
- keep more than 7,000 cars per day out of New York City, reducing congestion and exhaust fumes

Also, NY Waterway's fleet of 50 buses provides seamless connections on free shuttle bus routes.

"Our commuter ferries provide safe, convenient and efficient commuter services, reducing traffic and pollution in the Metropolitan area," says NY Waterway Founder Arthur E. Imperatore, who founded the business in 1986.

Routes include:

- East River, connecting E 34th Street and Pier 11 in Manhattan to Long Island City in Queens and Greenpoint, North Williamsburg, South Williamsburg and DUMBO in Brooklyn, seven days a week
- Port Imperial in Weehawken NJ, to West 39th Street in Manhattan, all day, seven days a week
- Port Imperial to World Financial Center, morning/evening rush hours, weekdays
- Port Imperial to Pier 11 at Wall Street, morning/evening rush hours, weekdays
